
### Discuss It! | Hide and Seek

### Do This! | Color Swirl Activity

**What You Need:** Milk, food coloring, dish soap, pie pan, cotton swab **What You Do:** 

- Pour milk into a pie pan.
- Have your children help you add several drops of food coloring, being careful to space them out and not to shake the pan.
- Place some dish soap and the end of a cotton swab and have your child dip it in the pie dish next to a dot of color to see what happens!

- Have your children swirl through the dots of color to create a beautiful rainbow.
- Say: Just like the milk completely changed with the food coloring, Saul's life was completely changed when he met Jesus.
