## STATE OF MICHIGAN FOOD PROGRAMS

### 1. **Double-Up Bucks**

Using your Bridge card, earn up to \$10 per day by spending up to \$10 per day on fresh fruits and vegetables at participating Double-Up Bucks locations (primarily Farmer's Markets and individually owned grocery stores).

### 2. **Food Assistance Program (FAP) ← START HERE**

FAP is the name of Michigan's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). SNAP is funded by Federal money. Recipients of this program receive a Michigan Bridge card with the funds loaded on the card each month.

Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a federally-funded special SNAP program administered by the State of Michigan. It serves low and moderate income pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women, infants, and children up to age five who are found to be at nutritional risk. WIC provide food, infant formula, education and support for breastfeeding and nutritional support. WIC Project FRESH offers coupons to purchase fresh produce at local farmer's markets.
